What is the lesson objective?

SWBAT: learn, identify, and create the plot elements of a story.

Standards addressed and expectations of students:

S2 C1 PO1 – Plot Elements: Describe, identify, and apply plot elements (exposition, rising action, climax, falling action, and resolution) in a piece of literature.

Instruction:

Students were first given children's short stories to read and identify the plot elements within them. Then, we went over the answers they came up with and discussed any misunderstandings.

Next, students were assigned to work with their teams to discuss, plot out, and create their own child's short story. They used the story elements to plot out the story. Then they used the internet to find pictures to illustrate their pages.

Once all of the pieces were put together the books were laminated and bound. Then, the books were given to the Early Childhood Development students to use as they created props for the books.
