

## ELIGIBILITY FOR THE WEST-MEC RECOGNITION CEREMONY

West-MEC students in good standing will be invited to participate in the annual student recognition ceremony. Good standing criteria will be based upon, but not limited to, the following:

1. Students must have completed or be in the process of successfully completing a West-MEC Central Program.
2. Students must be passing all West-MEC course work in which they are enrolled.
3. Students must be on track to earn the required program hours, outlined in the guideline below:

4. Student discipline, excessive absences and/or tardies, may prevent participation in the recognition ceremony at the discretion of district administration.
5. Students must have paid all fees prior to the recognition ceremony.
